- We use 'that' for anything that is further away. Things that we need to point to.

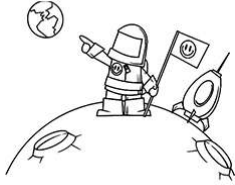

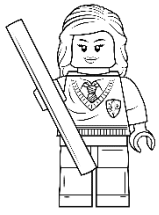
