



Personal Pronouns: They & We

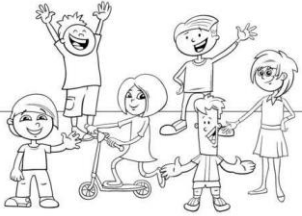

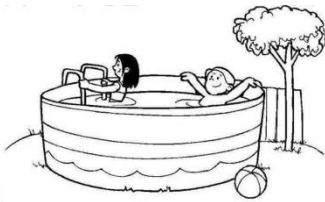


