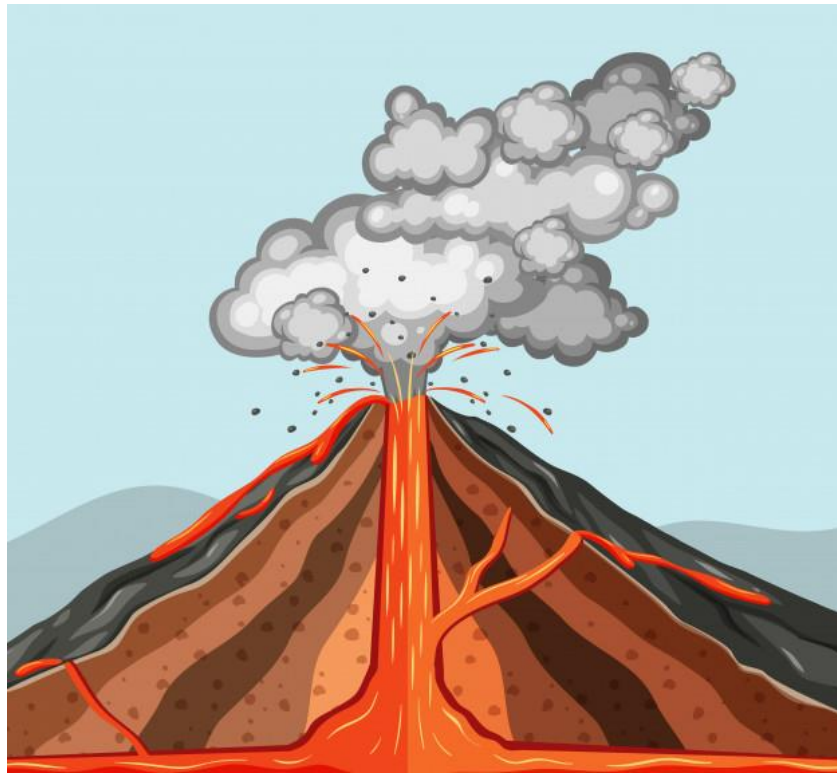


Primary Worksheets: Volcanoes



A volcano is a mountain. It has an opening that leads to a pool of molten rock from below the surface of the Earth. Volcanos can erupt if enough pressure builds up. Lava and hot ash will flow out from the volcano, causing a lot of damage to whatever comes in contact.
