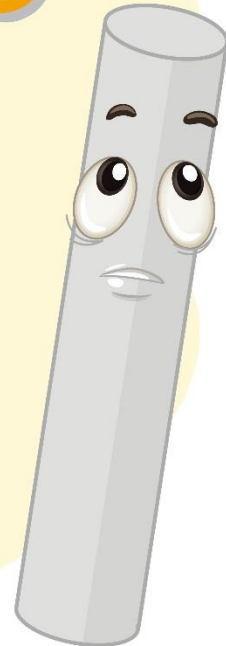

## hog the limelight

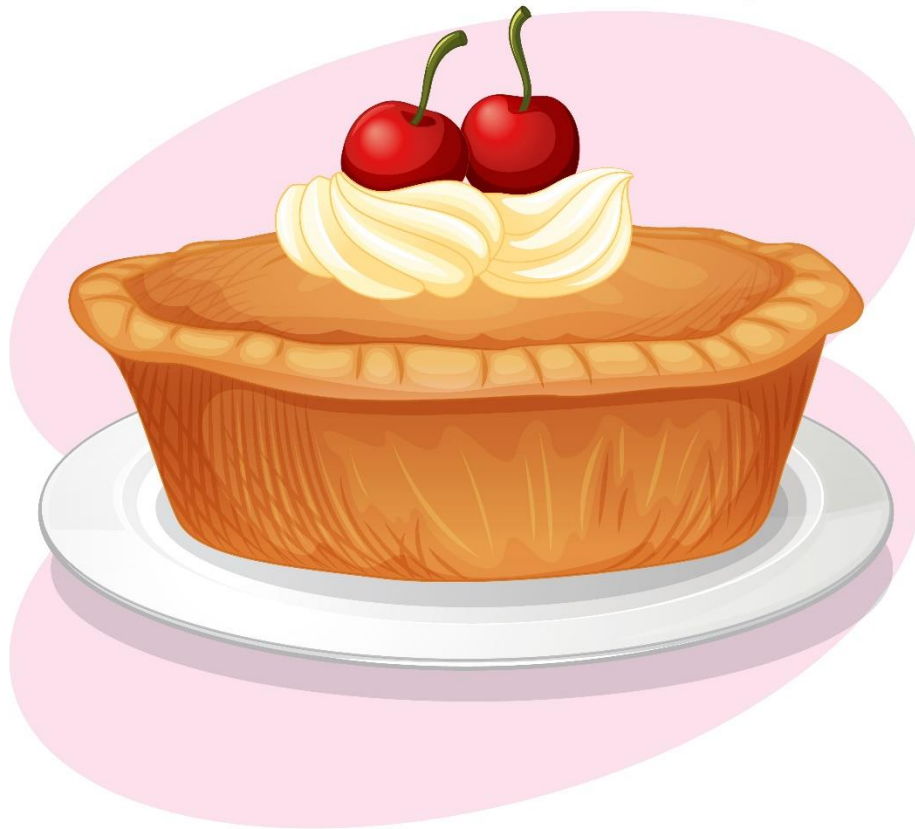


**Meaning:** taking too much attention
